How Can You Apply?

To be eligible you must:

- Be at least 18 years of age; and
- Be in good health i.e. not suffering from any contagious diseases; and
- Contribute a non refundable contribution of
 - at least €600,000 if you wish to become a citizen after 3 years

or

- at least €750,000 if you wish to become a citizen after 1 year
- Purchase a residential property valued at least €700,000 or enter in to a property rental agreement for a minimum of €16,000 per annum for 5 years; and
- Donate at least €10,000 to a registered charity in Malta.



Application Process Flow

•Client gives a power of attorney to Coates Global Malta to represent him/her and act on his/her behalf for the whole duration of the application process

 Coates Global Malta makes initial due diligence application on behal of the client and obtains first police clearance to start residency application

> Step 1- Initial Due Diligence

Step 2- Residency Application

- •Client and family members travel to Malta to submit their biometric enrolments for their residency application. Client normally receives their residence cards within 7 working days after application
- Once they receive their residence cards, client and family members can return their home country and citizenship process legally starts

DAYS: 0 - 7

- •Coates Global Malta submits Citizenship eligibility application
- Birth and marriage certificates are submitted to Public Registry and Passport Office by Coates Global Malta.

DAYS:8-120

Step 4- Second Due Diligence

- •Malta performs due diligence process and presents the application and its findings to the Interior Minister.
- On the Minister's instructions, Coates Global will be informed if the client is eligible to apply for Maltese Citizenship.

DAYS: 121 - 340

Application Process Flow (contd)

 After 12 months or 36 months from the date when the residence card was issued, Coates Global presents the Citizenship application to Maltese Officials.

Step 6- Citizenship Decision

- •Malta updates its due diligence on the client and presents its final findings to the Minister.
- •On the Minister's instructions, Coates Global will be informed the Minister's decision if the client can be granted Maltese Citizenship.

YEAR 1 + 30 days or YEAR 3 + 30 days (For lower investment)

- •Once the client fulfils the Exceptional Investment, Donation and Property requirements, Applicant is invited to come to Malta and takes the Oath of Allegiance.
- Applicant is granted Maltese Citizenship and is issued with a Certificate of Naturalisation to obtain their passports

Step 7- Passport Application

Step 8-Monitoring

- •Client needs to keep its property investment/rental agreement in place and fulfil other requirements for five years.
- •Maltese Officials conduct continuous monitoring during this five year period.
