FINANCIAL & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To qualify, applicants must demonstrate they can support themselves without working in Greece. Income must be passive and sourced from abroad.

Minimum Annual Income Required:

- €42,000 – Primary Applicant
- €8,400 – Spouse
- €6,300 – Per Dependent Child

As an alternative to demonstrating regular income, applicants may instead present a **lump sum savings deposit equal to twice the total annual income requirement**, held in a Greek or international bank account. This deposit must be **freely accessible**, and **not tied to any investment or loan obligation**.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Proof of long-term accommodation in Greece (rental or owned)
- Private health insurance covering the applicant and dependants
- Clear criminal record from country of residence

FEES & EXPENSES

The following fees apply to the Greece FIP Visa:

Government Fees:

- Application: €1,000 per adult
- Residence Permit Issuance: €16 per applicant

Legal & Advisory Fees:

- Coates Global Support: €9,000–€15,000 (based on case complexity)
- Document Translation & Legalisation: €300–€500

Health Insurance:

- €300–€1,000 per person annually

Other Costs:

- Rental accommodation: From €500/month
- Tax ID (AFM) registration: €50–€100
- Greek bank account setup: €200–€300
